7. Any additional borings that may be needed at a later date will require a separate application be filed with this office along with the \$25.00 (twenty-five dollar) processing fee and the \$100.00 (one hundred dollar) inspection fee.
8. Any abandoned borings shall be properly sealed as required by the Health Department.
