Dear Mr. Karlyk:

Enclosed is a draft copy of the report "Final Corrective Action Plan, Naval Exchange Service Station, Naval Air Station Memphis, Millington, Tennessee" for your review and comment. Please note that the report includes consideration of soil contamination and ground water contamination, it follows the CAP format, compares the 1992 distribution of contaminated ground water to previous years, and defines cleanup levels as agreed to in my letter of November 2, 1992.

In this report, we recommend non-enhanced bioremediation as the most appropriate remedial action. This is not a no-action alternative, as the data clearly show that natural microbial activity is presently removing contaminants from the system. Because there is presently no point-of-contact between humans and the contamination, this is clearly the most cost-effective and technically feasible remediation alternative.

Please note that this is a provisional draft pending Director's approval, and is subject to revision based on your review and other technical reviews. We will submit a final report when the review process is complete.
