In accordance with Technical Guidance Document 007, enclosure (1) is submitted for Facility ID #0-791707.

We plan to remove tanks 106 and 107 at this site in March 1996. As shown in Figure 1 of enclosure (1), the proximity of monitoring well No. 2 to the tanks will likely result in this well being destroyed during closure. A determination from you is requested as to whether replacement of the well will be required. Before abandonment of the well, the necessary well closure permit will be acquired from the Memphis\Shelby County Health Department.
