The Division of Solid Waste Management (Division) has completed the review of the above referenced investigation report for SWMU 65, prepared by Quantum Environmental & Engineering Services, dated October 4, 2012. The investigation was required to confirm the absence of petroleum contamination in the groundwater adjacent to former monitoring well 065G01UA.

Three soil borings were installed adjacent to the former 065G01UA well location. Samples were collected at 10-12 feet below ground surface. Groundwater was encountered in only one boring (065DPT02). A groundwater sample was collected and submitted for analysis. The soil and groundwater contaminant concentrations did not exceed Division of Underground Storage Tanks action limits. Based on these results no further action is recommended at SWMU 65.
