Dear Mr. Thomas:

It is our understanding, based on a telephone conversation between yourself and Mr. Mark Taylor of Southern Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command on 24 April 1992, that approximately 150 cubic yards of bulk concrete remaining at the N-94 tank farm site can be managed as follows:

-Five representative samples from the concrete rubble pile will be selected and placed on polyethylene sheets individually in a topographically depressed area on-site. Each representative sample will be pressure washed with tap water in the indented area. After all five concrete samples have been pressure washed one composite water sample will be retrieved and analyzed in accordance with hazardous waste determination criteria (TCLP and F001 - F005 solvent scan). The remaining rinseate will be pumped into a 55 gallon drum, staged on-site, and disposed of properly when analytical results are obtained. Also, the polyethylene sheets will be containerized separately, staged on-site, and properly disposed of when analytical results are acquired.

-If the analytical results reveal the rinseate to be non-hazardous, all concrete will be disposed of as a non-hazardous "special waste" in accordance with Tennessee Solid Waste regulations. If analytical results indicate the rinseate to be a characteristic or listed RCRA waste, your department will be contacted promptly for further assistance with other possible disposal options for the bulk concrete.
