

I have completed the technical review of the Contamination Assessment Report (CAR) dated December 1996 (received December 9, 1996) submitted for Building 2040. I agree with the recommendation for removal of free product and excessively contaminated soil. Free product may be removed using the bioslurping method used for free product removal at Buildings 7171 and 7174. After these removals, please submit a CAR Addendum indicating that all excessively contaminated soil has been removed, along with the groundwater analytical results.
