

I have completed the technical review of the above letter report dated May 28, 1998 (received June 1, 1998) submitted for Building 200. I agree with the recommendations for an additional round of sampling. After the additional round of sampling, a Site Assessment Report (SAR) addendum should be submitted. Also, note that in addition to TRPH exceeding the Groundwater Cleanup Target Level (GCTL) in well MW-8, dibenz(a,h)anthracene exceeded the GCTL in well MW-6.
