Dear Mr. Hansel:

I have completed my review of the Third Quarter Monitoring Report for Building 2036, Main Base, NTC Orlando, dated March 31, 1999 (received April 2, 1999), prepared and submitted by Harding Lawson Associates (HLA). As free product was discovered in monitoring well MW-1, I concur with the recommendations by HLA that the monitoring program be discontinued and free product recovery initiated. It may also be necessary to conduct further assessment of soil and groundwater at the site to determine the extent of contamination.

It was stated in the monitoring report that MW-2 was dry during the third quarter sampling event. This is somewhat confusing because MW-2 has historically had a higher water level elevation than the other monitoring wells on the site. If water table elevations remain depressed, it may become necessary to install an additional monitoring well in the vicinity of MW-2 with a screen that intercepts the depressed water table.
