Dear Mr. Hansel:

I have completed my review of the Harding Lawson Associates (HLA) letter report concerning Lake Druid PAHs at Operable Unit 4, NTC Orlando, dated October 18, 1999 (received on the same date). The letter report was written in response to comments relating to contaminants detected in sediments during the Remedial Investigation of Operable Unit 4. HLA and the Navy have maintained that PAHs, PCBs and pesticides (primarily DDT and chlordane) detected in sediments were due to stormwater discharges to Lake Druid from the surrounding urban environment. The letter report adequately supports the assumption made in the Draft Remedial Investigation Report that the contaminants detected were very likely from stormwater discharges from properties other than Operable Unit 4. I now concur that PAHs, PCBs and pesticides may be screened off the COPC list (using the argument supported by the letter report) in the Ecological Risk Assessment part of the Remedial Investigation for further study and risk evaluation.
