Dear Mr. Hansel:

I have completed my review of the Quarterly Groundwater Sampling Report for Study Area 52, Naval Training Center Orlando, dated January 10, 2000 (received January 14, 2000), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The document is suitable for its intended use. From the data that has been collected to date, it would appear plausible that groundwater samples collected July 27, 1999 from OLD-52-12 and OLD-52-13 were inadvertently switched. As the concentration of dieldrin detected in downgradient well OLD-52-12 dropped to below the detection level ( $<.05 \mu\text{g}/\text{l}$ ) in the October 24, 1999 sample, further delineation of dieldrin in groundwater is not necessary at this time.
