

Dear Mr. Twedell:

This letter is in response to your letter dated June 2, 2000, requesting written clarification that successful achievement of the remediation goals as described in the approved RAP will result in the issuance of an unconditional No Further Action letter from the Department. I assume that by "unconditional," you are referring to a No Further Action letter without land use restrictions. If post remediation confirmatory sampling conducted in accordance with the RAP does not identify any soils on the golf course parcel with arsenic concentrations above the residential cleanup goal of 1.0 mg/kg, a No Further Action letter would be issued without a requirement for land use restrictions. However, as the RAP for this site only addresses the remediation of arsenic contamination, any No Further Action letter would be limited to arsenic contamination. It would not address any contaminant that was not detected and that may be left after remedial activities because of the limited focus of the work conducted on the golf course parcel.
