

Dear Mr. Hansel:

I have completed the review of the Decision Document, Study Area 21, McCoy Annex, Naval Training Center Orlando, dated May 4, 2000 (received May 11, 2000) with signature pages received June 1, 2000. I have the following comments that need to be addressed prior to the Department's approval of the selected remedy:

- (1) One part of the selected remedy consists of a land use restriction to non-residential on the western portion of the site. The exact mechanism by which this land use restriction is to be enacted in the deed needs to be spelled out. An agreement has been reached between the Navy, FDEP and the City of Orlando that institutional controls are to be enacted through restrictive covenants to the deed granting perpetual conservation easements to FDEP for the purpose of enforcing the institutional controls. The restrictive covenants would be removed only upon receipt of concurrence from FDEP that the institutional controls are no longer required.
