





**SUBJECT:** Final Construction Documentation Report for Biosparge System at Building 7174, McCoy Annex, Naval Training Center, Orlando, Florida.

I reviewed the subject engineering document dated February 2000 (received February 9, 2000). I noted in a memorandum to you dated June 16, 2000, that I was unable to comment or approve this final engineering document since it was not signed or sealed by an appropriate professional.

Final engineering and geological documents must be signed and sealed by an appropriate professional with responsible charge when filed for the public record. Engineers who fail to comply with this requirement may be violating the Florida Board of Professional Engineers' Rule 61G15-23.002, Seal, Signature and Date Shall Be Affixed, and could be liable to sanctions from the Board. Professional geologists have similar requirements. Engineers submitting engineering documents to public agencies who have questions about this rule can contact the Board for clarification at FBPE, 1208 Hays Street, Tallahassee, FL 32301.

The signed and sealed final record drawings dated March 22, 2000 (received March 27, 2000), that I subsequently received correct this deficiency. Mr. Steven N. Tsangaris, P.E., Florida Professional Engineer No. 47091, is the engineer of record for these final engineering documents. The subject final report and drawings are adequate for their intent.
