


Dear Mr. Ugolini:

I have completed the review of the Site Assessment Report (SAR) Addendum for Building 7175, McCoy Annex, Naval Training Center Orlando, dated May 19, 2000 (received May 23, 2000), prepared and submitted by Harding Lawson Associates. I concur with the decision to emplace a downgradient well in the location specified south of the drainage ditch. A Monitoring Only Plan cannot be approved at this time as the benzene plume has not been completely delineated. A SAR Addendum II should be prepared consisting of sampling and analyzing the monitoring wells proposed in the monitoring plan as well as monitoring wells MC-4, MC-6 and MC-10. Groundwater from all wells should be analyzed for EPA Method 602. Monitoring wells MC-2, MC-7, MC-9 and MW-7 should also be analyzed for PAHs. Depending on the results, an updated Monitoring Only Plan may be submitted.
