I have completed the review of the Source Removal Report (SRR) for Building 7151, McCoy Annex, Naval Training Center, Orlando, dated November 2000 (received November 3, 2000), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The report adequately describes the soil removal activities conducted at this site. While it appears that all contaminated soil located above the capillary fringe or smear zone has been successfully removed, there appears to have been some contamination left in the capillary fringe outside of the excavation's boundary. This residual contamination appears to have been left because of the proximity of Building 7151 and the presence to the north of a 6 inch fire main. The contamination in the smear zone should be further addressed along with groundwater contamination in a Site Assessment Report.
