

Dear Mr. Twedell:

I have completed the review of the Revised Work Plan for Study Areas 39 and 40, Former Naval Training Center, Orlando, received April 5, 2001, prepared and submitted by Nodarse & Associates, Inc. The Work Plan is acceptable as written. The goal of the Interim Remedial Actions specified in the Work Plan is to clean up the sites to unrestricted use.

The Work Plan specifies the remediation of Study Area 39 to unrestricted use through the excavation of soils from 0 to 2 feet and disposal of those soils at the North Grinder Landfill site, Operable Unit 1, Parcel 4. The Work Plan specifies that to confirm that all contaminated soils in excess of residential Soil Cleanup Target Levels (SCTLs) have been removed, side-walls will be sampled at 50 foot increments.

Remediation of contaminated soil at Study Area 40 will be handled by either: 1) additional mixing and blending of contaminated soil, followed by testing and removal of remaining contaminated soil to the North Grinder Landfill site, Operable Unit 1, Parcel 4, or 2) the removal of the entire footprint of remaining contaminated soils and disposal of those soils at the North Grinder Landfill site.
