As requested in our letter of April 13, 2001, and approved in your letter of April 27, 2001 to Wayne Hansel of Southern Division, Tetra Tech NUS pumped groundwater from monitoring well OLD-52-13 at Study Area 52 and discharged the water to the City of Orlando's sanitary sewer. The study area is located at the McCoy Annex of the former Naval Training Center, Orlando. The discharge was performed under the guidelines of the City of Orlando's Sanitary Sewer Use Ordinance (Chapter 30) and the Navy's Industrial User Discharge Permit (CO85TA). The discharge dates and volumes are presented below:
