In accordance with Chapter 62-770.300, Florida Administrative Code (FAC), the following is provided. On October 29, 1996, ABB Environmental Services, Inc. was present to oversee and delineate the removal of petroleum contaminated soil from the above-referenced site. The soil excavation was performed by an United States Navy tank removal crew (PWD Pensacola). Approximately 35 cubic yards of petroleum contaminated soil was removed during this event. Headspace organic vapor analyses were performed to determine the extent of soil contamination by using a calibrated Foxboro 128 organic vapor analyzer, following procedures outlined in Chapter 62-770, FAC. After removal, the soil was stockpiled on plastic sheeting prior to transport by the Navy to a thermal treatment facility for disposal.
