

The Bureau of Waste Cleanup has reviewed the Site Assessment Report (SAR) dated January 1998 (received February 13, 1998), submitted for this site and concur with the proposal to submit a Remedial Action Plan. We found all the documents submitted to date to be adequate to meet the site assessment requirements of Rules 62-770.600, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). Therefore, you must now submit a Remedial Action Plan (RAP) in accordance with Rule 62-770.700, F.A.C. In addition, free product recovery must occur within three days of discovery. If free product recovery is not occurring, than you must begin immediate recovery as per Chapter 62-770.300, F.A.C.
