1. Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Navy Co-Chairperson, CDR Joe Monochino. The minutes of the 19 November 1996 <sup>AD</sup> meeting were reviewed and approved.

2. Thomas McAlpin Memorial

It was brought to the attention of those present who may not have been aware that Thomas McAlpin, a member of the Restoration Advisory Board, passed away just before Christmas of 1996. Mr. McAlpin's review and input concerning documents brought before the RAB was evidence of his personal dedication and commitment to the success of not only the RAB, but to the eventual environmental restoration of Pensacola Naval Air Station. The Public Affairs Office agreed to draft a letter to his family expressing the gratitude of the RAB for Mr. McAlpin's participation as well as their sympathy to his family.

3. Community Concerns

Jerry Westmoreland brought it to the attention of the RAB that the foam has reappeared in the ditch located at the northwest corner of the base. Mr. Westmoreland stated that he would bring it to the attention of Escambia County since previous sampling results showed that the foam was not originating from the Naval Air Station but rather from a ditch located off base property.

Mr. John Early stated that a gasoline spill as a result of an automobile accident was responded to at the intersection of Fairfield Drive and U.S.Hwy. 98.

4. Mailing List And RAB Letter

Mr. Keith Cornett distributed the mailing list and RAB letter for final review before distribution.

5. Public Information Options

Mr. Keith Cornett reserved the BLAB television show "NAS LIVE" on 12 March for an appearance by members of the RAB. Ms. Lisa Minshew and Mr. Jerry Westmoreland agreed to appear.

6. Contaminate Source Survey

Henry Beiro of Ensafe Allen and Hoshall presented an updated Contaminate Source Survey map. Mr. Beiro produced a revised version of this map mounted on a foam backing and delivered it to Ms. Lisa Minshew for use during the BLAB television appearance on 12 March.

7. Progress Report

Mr. Henry Beiro presented the progress report outlining the progress of the Installation Restoration program through February 1997. Planned activities for March were also discussed.

8. Update of Investigations At Sites 40 & 41

Mr. Henry Beiro informed the RAB that the analytical and toxicological parameters for the ecological risk assessment for site 40 & 41 are being determined. The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection and the Environmental Protection Agency are working with the Navy in this effort.

9. Other Business:




Next meeting is scheduled for 25 March 1997.
