The Department has completed its review of the Revised Draft-Final Denitrification-Based Bioremediation Treatability Study Work Plan (TSWP) for UST Site 18, Naval Air Station Pensacola, dated December 2009 (received December 22, 2009), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The TSWP contains the information requested in the Department's June 25, 2009 comments on the Draft TSWP. Specifically, it contains a completed UIC memo form and the calculations for a zone of discharge (ZOD). Upon completion of the treatability study, the Department expects to see the results in a Remedial Action Plan Addendum that proposes a remedy to address petroleum contamination across the entire site. The TSWP may be finalized.
