In reference to your letter of July 27, 1995 regarding the monthly reports on the free product recovery activities being performed at the Tow Way Fuel Farm Facility, Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) #7; we are modifying the existing contract in order to perform additional field work so that we can address your comments.

The plan of action is to install additional vacuum recovery systems to evaluate their performance at this site as well as to develop the information necessary to address the comments in your letter.

Due to the time required to address these comments and to contractual procedures, we can not meet your due date of September 21, 1995. Additionally, funding to complete this effort will not be available until Fiscal Year 1996 (FY96), beginning on October 1, 1995. Therefore, we request a time extension until February 26, 1996 to provide a written response to the above referenced letter.
