



Subj: INSPECTION OF INFORMATION REPOSITORY LOCATED AT CEIBA'S  
TOWN HALL

1. On 10 May 96, I visited the Ceiba's town hall with the purpose of verifying the physical condition and location of the Information Repository for the Installation Restoration program located at that public facility. I was received by Ms. Sofia Pedraza, public affair person for the municipality of Ceiba. She showed me that the documents are kept in a file cabinet in her office. I indicated my interest to move the documents to the public library where they could be more accessible to the public. We then visited the public library and discuss with Mrs. A. Prieto, the librarian, the reasons to transfer the documents to the library. She was very receptive to the idea, but expressed a concern about dedicating limited bookcases to Navy documents. I indicated that the Navy is willing to provide them with some bookcases to properly display the documents. (LANTDIV's librarian, Mrs. Bonnie Capito indicated in her recent visit to the Station on 4 Apr 96 that bookcases can be supplied to libraries that express a need for them). Mrs. Prieto agreed to this and requested that, if possible, additional information about Roosevelt Roads history, geology, archeological findings, and natural resources be passed to the library to supplement the limited history of Ceiba that is available to the public.

2. The Installation Restoration program is required by CERCLA to maintain all documentation generated under the program in places readily available to the general public. Since the Station is not open to the public, the recommended place is the town library.
