1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy (SECNAV) approval of the disestablishment of Naval Activity Puerto Rico (NAVACT PUERTO RICO), per reference (a).

2. Background. This disestablishment is the result of completion of the activity mission of preserving facilities and infrastructure after the 2004 closing of Navy activities in Puerto Rico until such time as they could be turned over to the local re-use authority.

3. Organizational Changes. Disestablish NAVACT PUERTO RICO effective immediately. The following applies:

4. Action

a. Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC) will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to disestablish this shore activity.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will delete the PLA in the Central Directory Component and disestablish NAVACT PUERTO RICO PLA via messaging systems effective immediately upon CNIC request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Parkway, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696 via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. Disestablished command will be deactivated via messaging systems. Additional information on naval messaging can be obtained at <https://sailor.nmci.navy.smil.mil> or by contacting COMNAVNETWARCOM at the email or numbers above. (New direction - CNIC/COMNAVREG SE COMMAND ACTION REQUIRED regarding the PLA.)

c. Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will revise reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, shall be managed per SECNAV Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
