It is my understanding that the Environmental Protection Agency, Region 2 and the Navy BRAC Program Management Office are in final negotiations for the Draft Administrative Order on Consent (Order) for the former Naval Station Roosevelt Roads, also known as Naval Activity Puerto Rico.
