

Waldorf bank robbed suspect is captured

Annapolis man was just released from ja

Just five hours after a Waldorf bank was robbed yesterday, law enforcement officials caught the man they say did it — a 23-year-old Annapolis man who had just been released from prison on a burglary conviction.

According to Charles County sheriff's detectives and agents with the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the suspect is also responsible for another robbery earlier this month in Glen Burnie.

At 9:49 a.m. Tuesday, police

broadcast a lookout for a man who had held up the Old Line National Bank on Route 5. By 2 p.m., Charles County officers arrested Jeffrey David Hudson, 23, after tracing a license plate number that a bank employee had given them. He was arrested on his way home in Annapolis.

According to sheriff's detectives, Hudson walked into the bank, implied he had a gun, and demanded money. After he got the cash and fled, bank employees managed to get the tag number from the black Mazda Navajo he was driving, which allowed police to trace the own-

er's residence.

Police ran the temporary number on the Mazda traced it to the dealer where the car was bought the person who bought Mazda, police said, had been purchased by Hudson's girlfriend, who told Hudson was driving it. Hudson said that after quiet her, they were convicted, had no involvement in boyfriend's alleged robbery.

According to detectives, Hudson was caught coming to business in Annapolis, had apparently stopped
